On Thursday, at 2:00 in the church, we will be honoring the 100th anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.

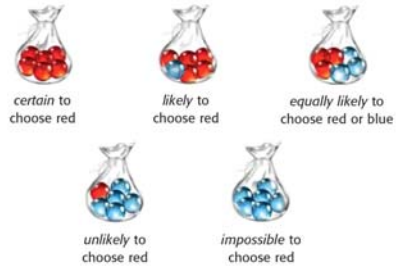


Math

Announcements: Our next Math test will be Tuesday, May 16th.

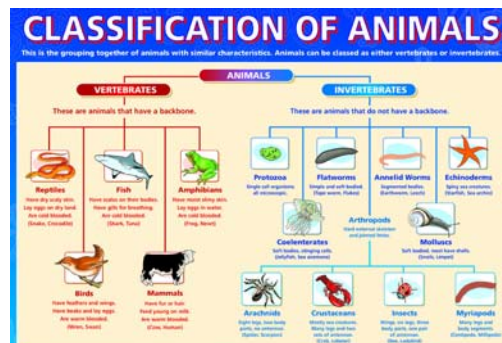
Please practice multiplication and division facts with your child daily.

Vocabulary: trait, vertebrate, amphibian, invertebrate, mollusk, arthropod; inherit, offspring, instinct



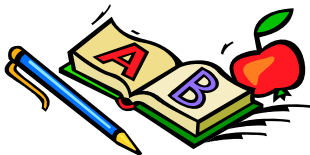
Social Studies
